Call for Posters

June, 2019

The poster session at the CAAPS 2019 Annual Convention (This year's theme is "Technological Innovation and Sustainable Management"), which will be held on August 17, 2019, 3~6PM at Phoenix Ballroom, 2nd Floor of the Sheraton LaGuardia East Hotel in Flushing, NY, is specially designed for scholars, graduate students to meet with accomplished convention attendees, to exchange ideas, to share experience and to network with them. Many of them are active researchers, and professionals. For those who are interested in this educational opportunity, please submit your poster abstract along with your biography to caaps.us@gmail.com before **July 7, 2019**.

Relevant topics include but are not limited to: 1: Technology Innovation and Applications, 2: Biomedical Technology and Healthy Life, 3: Emerging Information and Technology, 4: Economic Development and Sustainable Operation, 5: Higher Education Development, Session 6: Sustainability and Protecting the Environment, 7: Culture Inheritance and Innovation.

Your submission should include:

- (1) Title of the poster
- (2) The names/affiliations and contact information of the corresponding author
The names/affiliations and contact information of all authors
Underline the name of the poster presenter (one of the authors)
- (3) A biography of the presenter (400-700 words with a passport photo)
- (4) A 1-page abstract describing the content of the poster

The poster selection committee will review all submitted posters and notification of acceptance will be sent to the corresponding author by **July 15, 2019**.

Once your poster Abstract accepted, the presenter of an accepted poster is required to submit the PDF file of the poster before **July 31, 2019**, in order for the abstract of the poster and the biography of the presenter to be included in the convention proceedings. **Note that CAAPS Convention Proceedings were indexed in Library of Congress, at Capitol Hill, Washington, D.C. Since 2012.** The poster should be prepared on a tri-fold display board. The recommend size is 40"x28" oriented in the "landscape" position (long dimension is horizontal). You may edit the size of the font, the sections distribution and the colour scheme if wanted. All modifications concerning the background/title display are to be done at a Master Slide level. Please refer to file CAAPS 2019 - Poster template for preparations.
